ENROLMENT

Larne & Inver Primary School has an *excellent reputation* and, during my time here as principal, it is not difficult to see why. We are a family and work together to address all matters. The standard of teaching and pastoral care are excellent and I hope that everyone can see the progress being made each year. We currently have just over 200 children on roll and our current P1 children have settled very quickly and well into their new routines. Our enrolment has risen steadily over the past few years to the point where *we have now lowered our admissions number*, *with permission from DENI*, *to 30*. This means that we won't have any more large classes. If you have a child who is *due to start Primary 1 in September 2020*, please inform the school office so that pre-enrolment details may be completed. You may also know of some *parents/friends* who have recently moved into the area or who are currently undecided as to where to send their child/children next year. Please speak to them about school and ask them to make an appointment as I would be very interested in showing anyone around the school and informing them of the great work that is being done. We will also be having our *Open Event on Wednesday 13th November 2019* this year – further details will follow.

CHILD CARE FROM 8AM

Our Early Risers Club starts each day at 8am. Please send £2 with your child and remember that he/she can have breakfast in school consisting of cereal, toast and juice. Children may come every day or whenever suits. Really, to be feasible, we need about ten or more children per day. Mrs Hill is running this club in the P1 classroom (although the classroom may change in the future). If you do not wish your child to have breakfast but would still like to leave them to school at 8am, then feel free to send £1 for this. If you have any questions or require any additional information, please feel free to speak to me.



CONTACTING A TEACHER

For 'Child Protection' reasons, parents wishing to speak to a teacher should not go directly to the classroom. All visitors to the school must report to the Office, where a member of staff will assist you with your query and enable you to make an appointment with the class teacher if necessary.

Please also remember that, if you feel it essential to accompany your child into the playground each morning, you must NOT actively engage with any of the other children. This is for Child Protection reasons to keep YOU safe! As agreed, supervision starts at 8.45am and I must thank all parents who leave at or before this time.

MEDICAL FORMS

Many thanks to everyone who has completed the 'Administration of Medicine' forms. These are of vital importance. Please remember that *it is the responsibility of all parents* to ensure that medication is 'in date' and that school has a sufficient supply for your child. If you have any queries, please speak to either Ms McBurney or myself. *No child will be permitted to take any medication of any sort without previous parental consent using these forms*.

FREE SCHOOL MEALS

Many parents are entitled to free school meals and assistance with uniforms for their children. Even if your child does not always take a school dinner, but is entitled to free school meals, it is essential that you complete one of these forms (which are available from the school office). This will greatly assist with school administration and also help us to provide extra support if it is required. *Please speak immediately to Mrs Marcus at the office if you are not sure. Please also remember that the EA have requested that parents only send cash for school meals i.e. no cheques.*

Money envelopes are available to purchase at the school office for £3.
